- Isle Royale National Park entrance fees
- Invasive species eradication instruction and tools as required
- National Park Service boat transportation from Mott Island to Daisy Farm (round trip)
- Group campsite at Daisy Farm
- National Park Service boat transportation from Daisy Farm to Rock Harbor (round trip)
- Camaraderie with like-minded people who care about Isle Royale National Park!
